Purposes

- ★ ★ To avoid overcrowding or the likelihood of overcrowding
- ★ ★ To ensure that the selection of candidates for enrolment from outside the school zone, is fair and transparent.

Principles

- ★ ★ Students living within the zone, have the absolute right to enrol at anytime
- ★ ★ No more students are excluded than necessary to avoid overcrowding
- ★ ★ The zone established will touch or overlap the boundaries of any neighbouring scheme
- ★ ★ A consultative process will be used to establish the scheme
- ★ ★ The scheme will be regularly reviewed

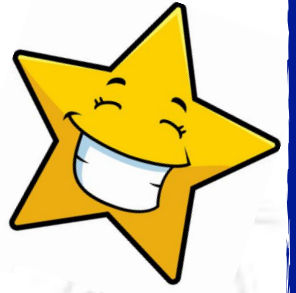
Home Zone

The home zone is the area surrounding the school (see attached). Students living within this 'Home Zone' have the right to enrol at anytime. Students outside of this may still enrol and would be selected in a fair and transparent manner according to Ministry of Education priorities and the number of spaces available. As a BOT we have discussed with the Ministry our desire to allow all currently enrolled students siblings a place in our school.

Priorities for Selection of Out-of-Zone Students

- ★ ★ First priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school: (Not applicable to Ranzau School)
- ★ ★ Second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school:
- ★ ★ Third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school:
- ★ ★ Fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school:
- ★ ★ Fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school:
- ★ ★ Sixth priority must be given to all other applicants
