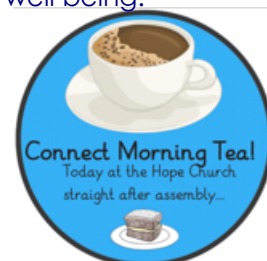

School Happenings

Meet the Teacher/Team: Thank you to everyone who turned out on Wednesday night. We had 82 parents attend the different sessions. The importance of families/whanau working in partnership with the school is a well documented positive for students learning and well being.

Swimming Lessons: This term all of our students will travel by bus to the **Aquatic Centre** in Richmond for ten swimming lessons. The swimmers will be assessed, grouped and given lessons by the Swim Magic instructors.

The ten-lesson swimming programme and the transport is heavily subsidised by the Kiwisport funding initiative and the school. The **cost per student will be \$45**. Payments can be made online or at the office **with family name and swimming as a reference. All payments to be received by 21st February 2020.**

As this is part of our NZ curriculum, we want all students to take part. If cost is a potential issue please come into the office and discuss it with us.

Summer Sports fees per student are: **Rippa \$5, Hardball \$25 & Volleyball \$35.00**. These are payable online with reference of name and sport or at the office.

Chickenpox is in our community at present. Chickenpox is contagious from 5 days before the blisters appear. It's most infectious in the last 2 days. It stays contagious until all the blisters have crusted over and no new ones are appearing – which usually takes another 5 days. Avoid close contact with other people during this period if you or a family member has chickenpox. Keep children home from school or day care.

School Sores (Impetigo): We have been informed that there are cases of School Sores. These are very contagious so please check your child for any sores. Impetigo appears as a pimple which then blisters and scabs. They increase in size rapidly and need to be treated promptly with antibiotics, either ointment or oral depending on the severity of the case. Please contact your doctor. Sores must be covered and children should be kept away from school for at least 24hours after the first treatment with antibiotics.
